What Does That Mean?

If you complete an intensive substance use disorder treatment program, it may take time off the end of your sentence. This time off is:

“Program Good Time Credit (PGTC)”

*PGTC depends on the type of program you successfully complete. Please see guidelines as outlined in the Course Catalog

To Receive Credit You Must:

- Have an active “Authorization for disclosure of information” with provider and DOC (if the ROI is revoked or revised credit will be denied)
- Be compliant with Conditions of Supervision (to include treatment recommendations as required by the sentencing authority, Court/Parole Board)

Are you Eligible?

If you are currently being supervised on:

*Misdemeanant cases, pretrial
Diversion, Probation, Parole, MRS*

tell your counselor so we can discuss sharing your completion with DOC.

***PGTC may be awarded at the discretion of the Judge involved in my case**
